*Space was taken away from current show members' spaces to create the temporary handicapped spaces.*

*That's probably why those spaces in the Art Section are 10 feet.*

*In the Crafts Section there was more open space, so these temporary handicapped spaces could be bigger.*

*Given that the Arts Section has had more open spaces in the last few months, perhaps a request to the Arts and Crafts Show Advisory Committee to create another temporary handicapped space, using an existing space, could be possible?\*\*\**

*I will get back with you when I have all the copies of the old minutes.*



All of the Handicapped beach show members (those in need for using any designated Handicap Spaces) shall have access to help overcome the handicap. The access shall be made by placing SUNDAY ONLY barricades at the curb in front or/nearly so. The barricades necessarily shall be clearly marked as to what they are there for, even to include a copy of the handicapped person's permit NO MISTAKING! When that show member does not intend to show, that message can be sent the day before, **NO BARRICADE.**

For the show member in designated handicap space 242--243; that handicapped person needs to be given a **FREE PARKING** pass to the parking lot for that day. **EQUALITY, AS TO SIZE**  
The designated handicap spaces of 10 feet in width **ARE NOT EQUAL** (necessary to comply with ADA)! Add at least five feet.

SINCE THE SPACE 150 --152 (a so-called new space) was NEVER a designated space .  
PURPORTEDLY THERE  
WAS AN ERROR OR SOMEONE'S WRONG MEASUREMENT WAS THE CAUSE OF THIS  
AND  
WITH SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION, THIS WAS FOUND.....  
WE ARE ASKING NOW---  
WHY COMPOUND THIS ERROR WITH ANOTHER???  
LONG HAS IT BEEN KNOWN THAT DISABLED SPACES (BE HONEST WITH YOURSELF?)  
HAVE NOT BEEN EQUAL AND WITHOUT ACCESS!!!

NOW IS MAYBE THE ONLY CHANCE TO MAKE THIS A TRUELY DISABLED SPACE WITH ACCESS.

We are very surprised that someone has not gone to the disabled rights division of the Department of Justice for the correction since it is 10 or more years that the disabled were denied equal---which is what the law says  
OR  
Just as harmful ---they might have GONE TO THE PRESS about this misrepresentation.

PALI, who got the space through the normal process that rules allow for, would prefer to, **TURN IT OVER TO THE POWERS THAT BE--** for the correction of this error. Pali would not mind to set up in the second row spaces until after the Bridge construction is completed

All of the Handicapped beach show members (those in need for using any designated Handicap Spaces), AND, especially Ali Sharouzi and Spencer Conway (they, who have gained spaces through seniority) shall have access to help overcome the handicap. The access shall be made by placing SUNDAY ONLY barricades at the curb in front or/nearly so ( in case of Ali). The barricades go up at the beginning of the show and are removed at the end.

The barricades necessarily shall be clearly marked as to what they are there for, even to include a copy of the handicapped person's permit NO MISTAKING! When that show member does not intend to show, that message can be sent the day before, **NO BARRICADE.**

For the show member in designated handicap space 238--239; that handicapped person needs to be given a **FREE PARKING** pass to the parking lot for that day.

**EQUALITY, AS TO SIZE**

The designated handicap spaces of 10-feet in width **ARE NOT EQUAL** (necessary to comply with ADA)! Add at least five feet!

**IN EFFORT TO COMPLY IN FULL WITH THE FEDERAL LAW AS TO ADA (AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT):**

If any disabled member prefers not to have barricades put out---their option would be to be given a city paid parking lot pass for show days, where the city has chosen to put all the disabled parking spaces.

**7. OLD BUSINESS**

**a. Ad Hoc Committee Report – Screening procedures, Violations**

Staff Recommendation: Receive report from Ad Hoc Committee members; ask questions; open public comment and bring back Committee for discussion.

The Committee reviewed the marked up copy of the Show's Rules and Regulations that Ms. Loperfido provided. A number of significant rule changes have been proposed by the Ad Hoc Committee

including changes in the rules relating to: length of elected terms, screening procedures, handling of complaints by monitors, procedures for changing the municipal code, statute of limitations on written customer complaints, reducing penalties for violating show rules, etc... The document will be reviewed at the next Ad Hoc Committee meeting, and committee members will make a recommendation to the Advisory Committee at that time. All members of the show are invited to attend and comment on the proposed changes.

**b. Update on Advisory Committee Election**

The Committee reviewed the Art Section ballot. It was moved and seconded to approve the ballot. The motion was seconded and carried. When all the candidate statements are received, staff was instructed to distribute to the Art Section.

Project is nearing completion. Mrs. McCaffrey reported that there are still challenges with show members parking in the loading/unloading zones all day preventing other members from using the zones. Police enforcement of these zones has not been consistent.

Show member Susan Smith asked that the No Skateboarding Signs be made bigger and be replaced on the light standards. She also inquired whether or not signs stating that no bicycles and surreys are allowed on the sidewalk would be posted. Mrs. McCaffrey replied that she was not aware of these signs being added, but that she would inquire.

Ms. Loperfido distributed copies of the News-Press Article about the Art Show. Mrs. McCaffrey thanks Marilyn for following up with the reporter and providing all the great photos. Ms. Loperfido also reported that she has represented the show with a promotional

booth at one concert in Chase Palm Park and at a local Tech Brew event. She encourages members to email her any images for any future promotional needs.

**10. CITATIONS, COMPLAINTS AND INCIDENTS**

Mrs. McCaffrey described on-going problems with Blue Bus parking in Art Section and band of transients setting up near the bathrooms at the base of State Street. She has been in contact numerous times with the SBPD regarding these issues and has instructed monitors to contact the Park Rangers and Police Department with any problems. By the City Municipal Code, no members of the public are allowed to conduct any commercial business on a City beach or in a City Park without a permit from the City. Show members are all issued permits, but anyone else attempting to sell any items or provide any services for a fee is doing so illegally. In addition, no amplified music is allowed in a City Park or beach without a permit. Please point these people out to the monitors or call the police and report them.
